


Finalities

Westinghouse Electric & Manufacturing buried two time capsules fifty feet under on the grounds of the World's fairs in 1939 and in 1964, to be opened 5,000 years later in the years 6939 and 6964. In the 1939 capsule, Albert Einstein wrote and signed the following message:

“Our time is rich in inventive minds, the inventions of which could facilitate our lives considerably. We are crossing the seas by power and utilise power also in order to relieve humanity from all tiring muscular work. We have learned to fly and we are able to send messages and news without any difficulty over the entire world through electric waves. However, the production and distribution of commodities is entirely unorganised so that everybody must live in fear of being eliminated from the economic cycle, in this way suffering for the want of everything.

Furthermore, people living in different countries kill each other at irregular time intervals, so that for this reason any one who thinks about the future must live in fear and terror. This is due to the fact that the intelligence and character of the masses is incomparably lower than the intelligence and character of the few who produce something valuable for the community. I trust that posterity will read these statements with a feeling of proud and justified superiority."
